

SKILL BOOSTER TEAM LEADER

Skill Booster sessions are designed to have a direct positive influence on the school curriculum and student outcomes. The curriculum resources focus on personal development, wellbeing and social action, ensuring that all students from mainstream and non-mainstream settings are supported to be ‘world-ready and work-ready’.

Learn by Design looking for candidates prepared to inspire and engage the young people the same way.

The Skill Booster Team Leader is a key role in the delivery of School Support Sessions at the assigned school or college. The role involves delivering and facilitating a total of 5 x ½ day sessions, up to 2 x sessions per day covering several topics that a school can choose from.

Each session would have 2 Skill Booster Team Leaders assigned to a maximum of 30 young people (NCS age 15-17) in their school setting.

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

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Main Responsibilities

- Attend a compulsory training event and engage with practicing facilitation.
- Read through Skill Booster session materials and prepare to facilitate to a classroom up to 30 young people.
- Maintain professional relationships with the school and other key stakeholders.
- Ensure all policies and procedures are followed and tasks are completed accurately throughout the sessions. Such tasks could include taking young people attendance.
- Deliver assigned content in a fun and engaging way, ensuring that young people get the most out of each session.
- Work collaboratively with your assigned colleague to coordinate workloads and to ensure that all curriculum is covered and delivered in a timely manner and professional manner.
- Adhere to staff code of conduct and wear your assigned uniform throughout the Skill Booster delivery.
